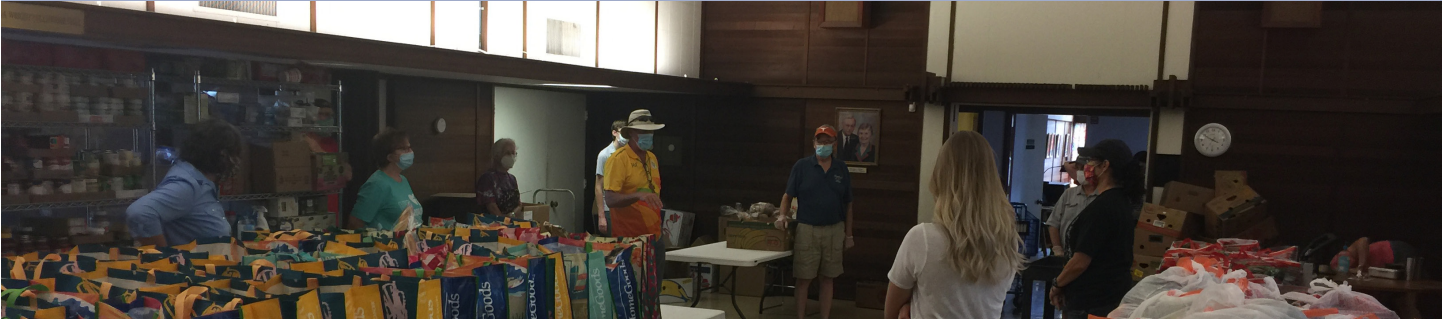

Q. What is Bread-for-All?

R. A Food Pantry that is collaborative ministry of Lutheran churches in Austin (Austin City Lutherans), serving our neighbors weekly for seven years!

Q. When does Bread-for-All serve our neighbors food?

R. Every Monday from 5:00-6:30 p.m., 50-70 individuals/families are served, representing 150-250 people being fed each and every week!

Q. How can I help?

R. Every Saturday from 9:00-11:00 a.m. we collect food. And, monetary donations provide twice as much food to be purchased!

*Thank you Shepherd of the Hills for being a leading congregation in this ministry. Since March we have received over 5000 lbs. of food (valued at \$8,350.00) and we have received monetary donations of over \$13,000.00.
