Dale Kenneth Mann passed away on May 10, 2018.

Dale had been a resident of Austin, Texas for the last 7 years.

He is survived by his wife, Evelyn, (married for 69 years) his son, Gregory, his daughter-in-law Linda, residents of Cedar Park, TX

He formerly resided in Las Vegas NV, Ft. Meyers FL, Dayton OH, Pittsburgh PA, and Jackson Center, Ohio

Born April 23, 1925, after graduating high school, he joined the US Navy, and subsequently that led to a college education and degree in Electrical Engineering from Case Western University in Cleveland, Ohio.

As an intelligent and articulate man, this led to starting a manufacturers representative company, with two partners, that specialized in selling state of the art electronic and medical test equipment. In the later stages of his career, he successfully launched a computer peripherals distribution company.

As a religious individual, he was thoroughly involved with the Lutheran Church. After serving in various positions within his local congregations, he was asked to study (2-year program) and become one of the initial teachers of the Bethel Series. He also served on the Bishop's Council in the state of Ohio. As a singer, he was a member of the choir in every congregation he served.

He was a visionary, a mentor, teacher, and wonderful parent. He built his first home. He loved golf after being introduced to the game after college. For the last 20 years he devoted a great amount of time to genealogy. What started as a family tree research project escalated into the three counties near where he was born and all the families from there, developing into a database exceeding 50,000 people.
