- Masks are strongly encouraged for all indoor worship & gatherings (including Bible studies and other groups that gather).
- Communion will be celebrated "in place," with individual wafers and cups. We will not be coming forward to the altar for Communion at this time.
- We are adapting the sanctuary space to facilitate social distancing, and our air filtration system in the sanctuary continues to work to provide fresh air throughout the space.
