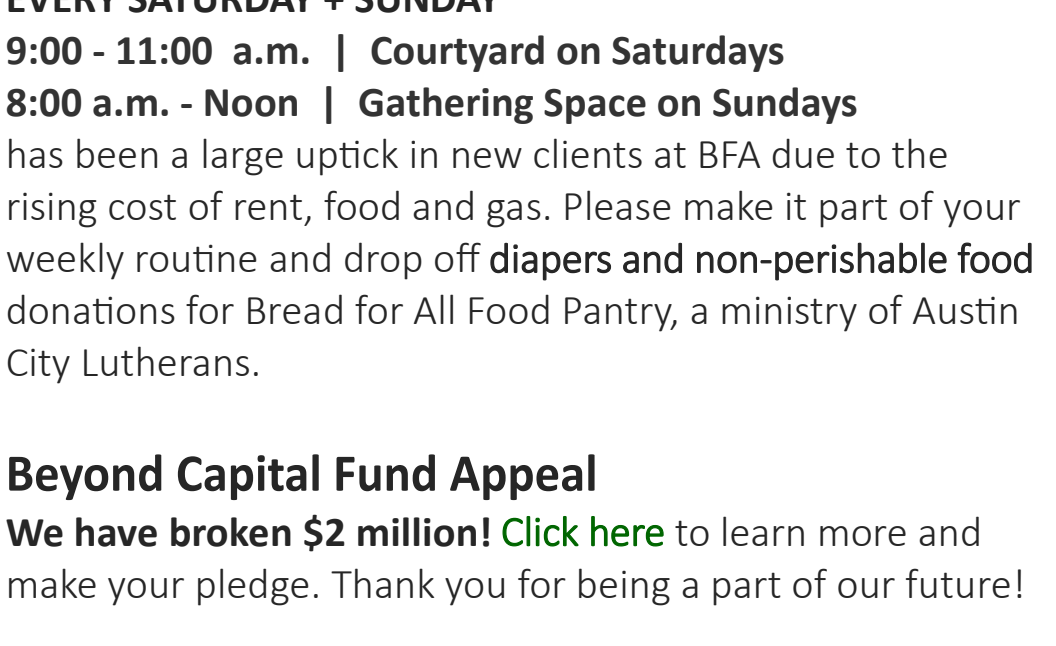

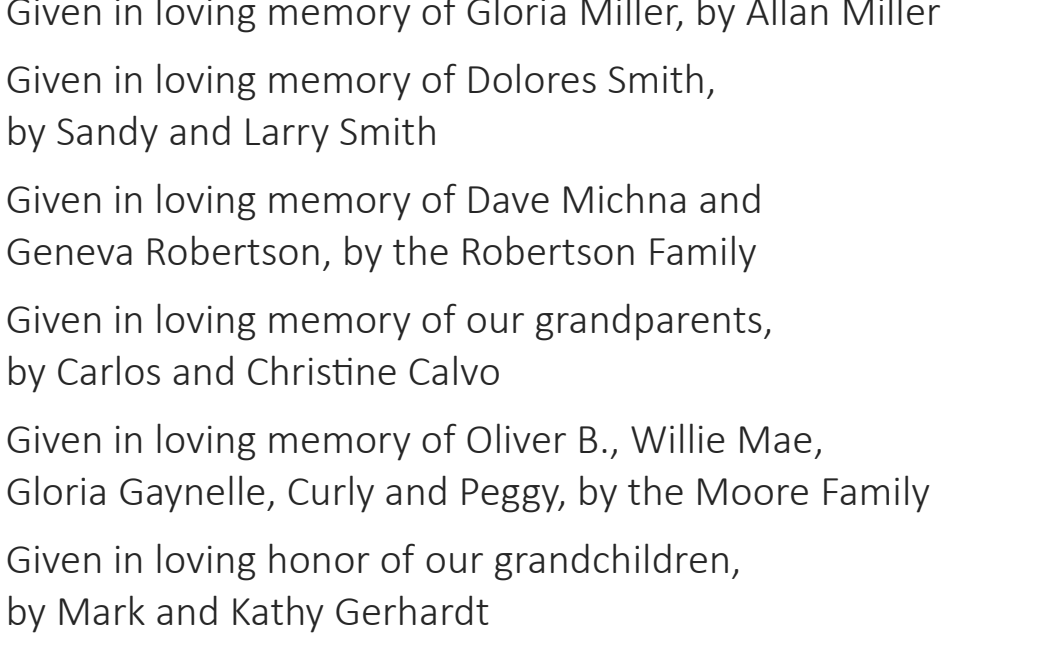
PALS (Parents of Addicted Loved Ones)

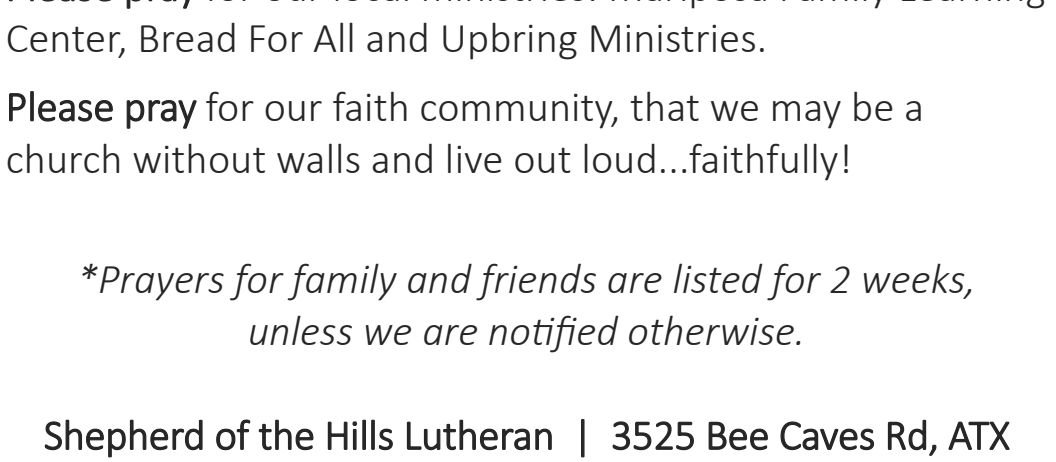
