SCRIPTURE STORY BACKGROUND

Pastor: Journey with Joseph, part 1

- A young Joseph dreams that he will be great--and that his brothers and family will bow down to him
- Joseph's brothers are jealous and want to kill him
- Instead, they get rid of him by selling him to a caravan of traders heading to Egypt
- The brothers lead their father, Jacob, to believe that Joseph has been killed by a wild animal, and Jacob grieves his son Joseph for many years

Leader: Journey with Joseph, part 2

- Once in Egypt, the traders sell Joseph to Pharaoh's official named Potiphar
- Potiphar is fond of Joseph and can see that God is with him;
 Potiphar elevates Joseph to become the manager of Potiphar's whole estate
- Potiphar's wife, out of jealousy for Joseph's affections, gets Joseph into trouble with Potiphar and thrown in jail
- While in jail, Joseph again becomes respected and is given responsibility over all of the other prisoners
- Joseph interprets the dreams of Pharaoh's cupbearer and baker,
 both of which turn out to be entirely accurate
- Joseph asks the cupbearer, "Please remember me when you get out of jail. Have Pharaoh release me."
- But the cupbearer forgets all about Joseph
