Homelessness Initiative Sheltering Ministry

ACL's strategy to combat homelessness is focused on four mission points:

- **1. Navigation** We'll encourage and help unhoused neighbors sign up for "Coordinated Assessment," the first step in transitioning from street to shelter.
- 2. Support Teams As we interact with unhoused neighbors, our "Necessities Support Team" will provide furniture, clothing, childcare (as available), and other necessities; our "Tech Support Team" will provide facility for SNAP, Social Security, and other registrations.
- **3.** Use of Church Property and Resources In the spirit of Peace Lutheran, we'll leverage unused resources to help unhoused neighbors in transition.
- **4. Education, Awareness, Advocacy** We'll continue to educate ourselves and work with partners, private and public, to be part of the growing effort in Austin to proactively combat homelessness.
