Assisting Minister: Prior to our Scripture reading, Peter and John have been speaking and teaching that in Jesus is the resurrection of the dead. And the priests and Sadducees are annoyed with them, and they arrest Peter and John and put them in jail. But many who had heard their proclamation believed it. And so we hear now what happens next in Acts, chapter 4:

The next day their rulers, elders, and scribes assembled in Jerusalem, with Annas the high priest, Caiaphas, John, and Alexander, and all who were of the high-priestly family. When they had made the prisoners stand in their midst, they inquired, "By what power or by what name did you do this?"

GOSPEL READING...JOHN 10:11-18 NRSV

Pastor:The Holy Gospel according to St. John.All:Glory to you, O Lord.

[Jesus said,] "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand, who is not the shepherd and does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and runs away - and the wolf snatches them and scatters them.

The hired hand runs away because a hired hand does not care for the sheep. I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. And I lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice.
